Good To Know

Hotels: Marriott Long Wharf – 296 State Street. Along Boston Harbor, close to Aquarium metro station and shopping and dining at Faneuil Hall Marketplace. Flat-screen TVs, iPod docks and Wi-Fi (fee), coffeemakers. A low-key restaurant with city views. Indoor pool, hot tub and gym.
Millennium Bostonian – 26 North Street, located in the heart of the Historic District, next to Faneuil Hall and Quincy Market. A short walk from a variety of the city's favorite attractions, including Boston Harbor, the North End, the New England Aquarium, and the Freedom Trail.
Best Arrival Day: Any day is good, but there are more daily departures for sightseeing tours between April 1-October 31 than the rest of the year.

Effective Dates: April 1 – October 31

Transfers: We recommend a taxi from Logan Airport to the hotels. It is close and rates are reasonable.

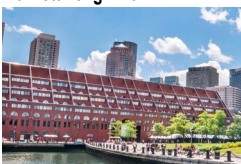

Sightseeing

ONE, TWO AND THREE DAY TROLLEY HOPPERS: On our orange and green Hop-on/off trolleys you will visit Downtown, Beacon Hill, Back Bay, and the Waterfront District. Stops include: Faneuil Hall, Historic North End, USS Constitution & Museum, TD Garden, Cambridge/Harvard, Cheers Bar, Copley Place Mall, Boston Common. Daily

BOSTON TEA PARTY SHIPS & MUSEUM: This unique museum sits on a barge in the water and includes tours on restored tea ships and a stunning, interactive documentary that immerses you into the events that led up to the American Revolution.

TROLLEY HOPPER & AQUARIUM: The tour includes a One Day Hopper (see above), combined with admission to the New England Aquarium, a global leader in ocean exploration and marine conservation. It is one of the premier visitor attractions in Boston, with over 1.3 million visitors a year, and a major public education resource.

TROLLEY & FREEDOM TRAIL PACKAGE: Includes a One Day Hopper (see above), and a Freedom Trail Tour. Enjoy a Walk Into History, a great way to experience the Freedom Trail. Led by 18th century costumed guides, this 90-minute tour mixes humor and history.

CAMBRIDGE, LEXINGTON, CONCORD TOUR: Journey back to the days of the American Revolution. View Cambridge Common where George Washington took control of the Continental Army. See the home of Henry Wadsworth Longfellow. Follow the route of Paul Revere as he warned that "the British are coming!" Stand on Lexington Green, where Captain Jonathan Parker and 77 Minutemen stood their ground against 700 of England's finest. In Concord, view the homes of Hawthorne, Alcott and Emerson. Visit the Old North Bridge where

the embattled farmers stood and fired the shot heard round the world.

TOTAL EXPERIENCE TOUR: This tour combines the Cambridge/Lexington/Concord tour with a stop at historic Faneuil Hall & Quincy Market. Time for lunch on your own before a comprehensive two-hour excursion of Boston, including a stop at the USS Constitution. 4 hours.

NEW ENGLAND SEACOAST: Travel north through Boston and its "North Shore" communities; through Hampton Beach, New Hampshire, a popular resort area. Continue along the rocky coast of Maine, view Cape Neddick Lighthouse. Enjoy the beauty of Maine's coast and the historic fishing village of Kennebunkport, Maine. 9 hours.

CAPE COD DAY TRIP: Ride across the Cape Cod Canal and travel through scenic Sandwich, MA, the oldest town on the Cape. Established in 1637, bursting with New England charm; gorgeous Cape Cod views. In Hyannis, board the cruise boat for a 45 minute tour of Lewis Bay to learn about local area and see the family compound of the Kennedys, with fascinating commentary. 9 hours.

TOUR TO SALEM (The Witch City): Travel north from Boston to historic Marblehead, the birthplace of the American Navy. Visit Abbott Hall and view the original painting, "The Spirit of 76." Once in Salem, you will have time to explore on your own. 7 hours.

TOUR TO PLIMOTH PLANTATION: Follow in the steps of the Pilgrims and "set sail" for Plymouth, America's Hometown. Visit Plimoth Plantation, a living re-creation of the small farming community built by the Pilgrims. Interact with the Pilgrims as they go about their daily tasks and learn what it was like to come to America to build their future. Visit other historical sites including Plymouth Rock. 8.5 hours.
